On a limited bay front site, this pavilion was designed to honor the competitive history and celebrate the future of the San Diego Rowing Club. The pavilion houses a century's worth of artifacts and acts as an event space for parties and other social events. The elongated event space is defined by a hull-shaped ceiling pulled from the edges of the room to reveal the sky and allow daylight to penetrate the space.
